Tomorrow begins our end of year testing for students. Students have worked hard this year; this is a chance for them to show how much they know.

We will begin testing each morning promptly at 8:45. Please make sure your student arrives on time to school and is in their team area, ready to go by 8:30. Students may eat breakfast at school for free if they so desire. Cell phones will be collected at the beginning of each testing session to adhere to district policy; however, you may choose to keep your child's phone at home during testing days.
