

The Knox County Health Department will be coming to Farragut High School on October 25, 8:45 a.m. to vaccinate students for the flu. This year, due to CDC recommendations, we will only be offering **flu shots**. Please answer all the questions on the consent form completely. If your student has medical insurance, please fill that section out completely. Money collected from the insurance company helps fund the flu vaccination program. Regardless of what your insurance company pays, there is **NO COST** to you for the vaccine. These forms are due to the student's 1st block teacher no later than October 18th.

Please make sure the student's upper arm is available for the nurse to vaccinate. Also make sure the student has had breakfast! Empty stomachs are not good with shots.

As a reminder, only flu shots are being offered this year. Our school's clinic date, once again, is October 25, 2016, during 1st block.
