In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Knox County Schools went online on 3/12/2020. Students were given no new instruction for the rest of the school year, but were allowed to turn in work to increase their semester grades, which remained on an A - F scale.

In August 2021, KCS re-opened as a 1-to-1district, with approximately 1/3 of students opting for virtual instruction. Virtual classes were asynchronous. This year all students are in person. We continue with our 1-to-1 program.
