The town of Farragut (pop. 24,472) is a rapidly growing, middle/upper income suburb of Knoxville, TN. The largest employers in the region include the Oak Ridge National Lab, Department of Energy, University of Tennessee, and Covenant, Tennova, and University Health Systems. The median household income is \$109,156. The population of Farragut, TN is 90.1% White alone, 6.8% Asian alone, 2.4% Hispanic or Latino, and .7% Black or African American alone. 8.4% of the people in Farragut, TN speak a non-English language at home. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Knox County Schools went online on 3/12/2020. Students were given no new instruction for the rest of the school year, but were allowed to turn in work to increase their semester grades, which remained on an A - F scale.

In August 2021, KCS re-opened as a 1-to-1 district, with approximately 1/3 of students opting for virtual instruction. Virtual classes were asynchronous. This year all students are in person. We continue with our 1-to-1 program.
