EPSO awareness is important because of the positive impact these courses can have on a students' future. Research shows that students who participate in EPSO courses are more likely to enroll in and graduate from college.

EPSOs allow students to become familiar with postsecondary expectations and develop the confidence and skills for success — this is particularly important for first generation collegegoing students.

EPSOs also decrease the time to complete an industry certificate or degree, saving students money.




