DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

Dual enrollment (DE) is when a student is enrolled with a college to take a class while a high school student.

- DE classes can take the place of a required high school course or an elective
- **Take 4 classes tuition free!** You only have to pay for your textbook.
- Online & asynchronous
- Students can work on their DE classes from home

REQUIREMENTS

Pellissippi State Community College

- For General Education classes = 3.6 GPA or 3.0 GPA & ACT English score ≥ 18 , Reading ≥ 19 , Math ≥ 19 ONLY if taking a math course
 - Popular Gen-Ed courses include:
English Composition I & II Introductory Statistics
Psychology Sociology
- For Non-Gen Ed courses = 2.0 GPA & ACT ≥ 13 on all sections
 - Popular Non-Gen Ed courses include:
Medical Terminology Introduction to Law Enforcement

Tusculum University

- 3.0 GPA or 2.75 GPA & ACT ≥ 21 - allowed to take two classes per term
- 2.75-2.99 - allowed to take one class per term
- Guaranteed placement in Nursing program if you complete 4 Tusculum DE courses with 3.0 GPA and 3 Gibbs Health Science classes with 3.0 GPA
 - Popular courses include:
English Composition I Statistics New Testament
Public Speaking Psychology Intro. to Criminal Justice
