TN Promise Scholarship



Last-dollar scholarship that covers the tuition and mandatory fees at any TN community college or TCAT. Some private four-year institutions also apply for a tuition discount if student is in associate degree program.

Regardless of what you want to do after high school, applying to TN Promise can keep you on track and help you make a plan.

Why apply?

- Great option to make college affordable
- Required for UT Promise eligibility
- Use it as a backup plan
- Start at a community college and transfer to a four-year later

FAFSA

- The *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA®) form is an application for federal student aid.
- You need to complete the FAFSA form to apply for federal student aid such as federal grants, work-study funds, and loans.
- In addition, many states and colleges use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for state and school aid. Some private aid providers may use your FAFSA information to determine whether you qualify for their aid.



Completing the FAFSA

1. Make your FSA ID **ASAP**

a. Who needs an FSA ID?

Student AND Parent/Guardian

2. Complete the FAFSA when it opens
on December 1st

You MUST have your **Social Security Number** to create and FSA ID and complete the FAFSA

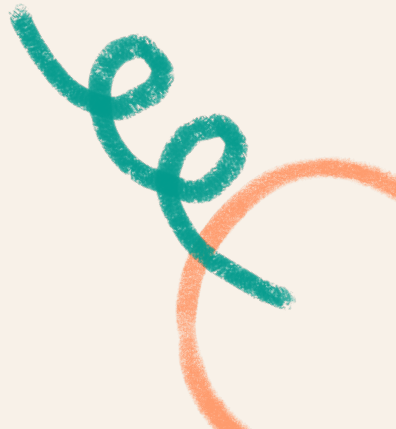
