Dear Students and Parents,

As we plan for this fall, we would like to communicate Dawg Days plans to ensure that all families are aware of the device deployment process so that all students have access to a MacBook in August. With a MacBook in hand, all students will have the opportunity to engage in personalized learning and collaboration throughout the school year.

Prior to deployment, students and parents must review the device deployment orientation presentation, read the device procedures and expectations document, and sign the technology agreement; all documents are available on Bearden High School's website. Paper copies are available in the West Mall Office at Bearden High School.

## **Returning Students**

- For students returning to Bearden, the device deployment orientation presentation can be viewed online or parents and students can attend an in-person device deployment orientation session at Bearden High School on Thursday, August 1st at 5:00 p.m.
- Each *returning* Bearden High student should sign up for a timeslot on SignUpGenius to receive his or her MacBook during Dawg Days on August 1st or August 5th. Students can sign up for any time slot, regardless of grade level.
- Students can access the SignUpGenius link, deployment documents, and beginning-of-year paperwork (Tech Agreement, Right to Publish, and Student Medical Profile) on Bearden High School's webpage.
- On deployment day, please bring all completed deployment and beginning-of-year paperwork with you. If a student does not bring a completed Technology Agreement—signed by student and parent—to Dawg Days, the student will not be allowed to go through the deployment process. For more information on what to expect when you arrive on deployment day, see the flowchart on the reverse side of this letter.

## 9th Grade/New Transfer Students

- All parents of students new to Bearden (i.e., freshmen or transfer students) must attend an in-person deployment orientation session either during Freshmen/New Student Orientation day on Thursday, August 1st at 8:30 a.m. in the auditorium or on Thursday, August 1st at 5:00 p.m. in the auditorium.
- Freshmen and/or new transfer students who attend orientation on August 1st should *not* select a timeslot on SignUpGenius. You will complete the Dawg Day tasks during orientation.
- Devices will be deployed to freshmen and new transfer students within the first two weeks of school.

As a final note, general (\$15) and technology fees (\$15) will be collected at Dawg Days. Students may pay with cash or check written to Bearden High School. This fee can also be paid online; see the BHS website for more information. Students will also have the opportunity to pay technology fines during Dawg Days. Students who owe a technology fine for past damages will not receive a device until the technology fine has been paid. Students may pay technology fines with cash or check written to Bearden High School.
