

Hello Blue Grass Parents and Guardians,

I wanted to let you know what has been going on and what is to come in your child's future guidance lessons. Every year we focus on three main domains: Academic Development, Social and Emotional Development, and College and Career Readiness. Starting out the year in the Social and Emotional domain, during the month of September we talked about Personal Safety, also known as Erin's Law, in all grade-levels. This is part of the School Counseling Curriculum that covers the TN School Counseling Standards SS2 and SS5. For a description of each standard, please refer back to the TN Standards link on the school counseling website.

Then we focused on Academic Development during the months of October and November. Each grade-level had their own set of standards that they focused on. Here is a list of topics with the standards we completed in each grade.

- Kindergarten Appropriate Positive Behaviors with Peers and Adults at School (AA5, AA2, AS5)
- 1st Grade Decision Making (AS3, AS4, AS7)
- 2nd Grade Goal Setting (AS6, AS1, AA3)
- 3rd Grade My Future (AA5, AA1, AS2)
- 4th Grade What's Your Mindset (AA2, AA4, AS6)
- 5th Grade Goals are a Game Plan for Achievement (AA3, AS4, AS7)

Now, we switch back to the Social and Emotional domain before winter break which will last until the 2nd week of January.

- Kindergarten Friendships (SA2, SE4, SK2, SK3)
- 1st Grade Cross Cultural Friendships (SS3, SS4, SA3, SA4)
- 2nd Grade Perseverance (SS6, SS7, SS8)
- 3rd Grade Peer Pressure (SS1, SK2, SA1, SE3)
- 4th Grade Respect and Caring about Diversity (SA3, SK3, SS3, SS4)
- 5th Grade APB with Peers and Adults at School (SE4, SS6, SS9, SS10)
