

What to Expect

<u>Transportation U</u> consists of daily sessions meeting Monday through Friday for a minimum of four (4) weeks. Classes are held from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with a 1 hour lunch break. Training will be held at the Sarah Simpson Professional Development Technology Center. Students are expected to make arrangements to be present <u>every day</u> for the duration of the training period.

Training will include:

- Intensive study of the Tennessee Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Manual Each student will receive their own CDL manual. This will be your own personal study guide - use it to make notes and highlight important information in preparation for the test over its content at the end of the first week
- > Instruction in Knox County Schools policies and procedures
- > Familiarization with federal and state mandates for pupil transportation
- > Becoming acquainted with the physical school bus and general outside practices
- > Practicing behind-the-wheel skills in a school bus
- Any and all training provided by Knox County Schools will follow CDC and Knox County Health Department COVID-19 guidelines in order to maintain a safe environment for everyone. Facial masks will be required and social distancing in the classroom will be followed. Classrooms will be disinfected prior to and subsequent to class meetings. Hand sanitizer will also be available to everyone.
