Group 1 – Adults/Parents:

- 1. In what areas is Knox County Schools doing well?
 - Communication from leadership
 - Students are well prepared for post high school
 - They make sure students don't fall through the cracks
 - Owning the areas they are not good at
 - Communication from various mediums
 - Transparency
 - Embraced the security issue. Taking it serious
 - Good job of staying ahead of initiatives (front end of education)
 - Inclusion of students with disabilities (especially in the arts)
 - Stretching the dollar

- 2. In what areas does Knox County Schools need to improve?
 - Various areas of equity (e.g. preparation, opportunities, expectations)

 - Resources for social and emotional needs (broader problem for community)
 - Need to expand Community Schools
 - Need for more interpreters (also expand for family needs)
 - Elementary curriculum needs to be deeper not broader
 - Recruitment of teachers to reflect diversity in classrooms
 - More opportunities for career and technical paths (and communicate the ones they already have)
 - Make sure every student knows they have opportunities post high school (e.g. TN Promise)
 - Giving students opportunities to attend things in the community (money to go to plays, etc.)
 - Maintain all school facilities
 - Foreign language instructions could be improved
 - Promote the integration of all kids (levels) in all classes
 - More parental involvement (either through communication or current opportunities)
 - Technology and maintenance of technology
 - Collective response between values of education and money spent
- 3. What would you like to see initiated in the future?
 - Dual emersion foreign language schools
 - More students using our public transportation system
 - Partnership with KAT to help with above
 - District-wide emphasis on healthy life (getting off technology at times)
 - KCS budget to reflect they are covering more than academics
