As we are taking a two year course into a one year course, it will be to YOUR benefit to get ahead this summer.

1. Read THREE plays. As school is out, you may access plays from the public library or online libraries. I have a script file in the team drive that you are welcome to use. Plays can typically be read in an hour. Read it for enjoyment first - imagine how it would look and sound onstage. At second reading, take notes according to questions. THEN, by August 22, you will need to have completed three IB Play reading reports

2. Make a list of EVERY play (or musical) that you can remember seeing in the last four or five years. Some of you will have longer lists than others and that is OK!!!! When you write down the name of the play, jot some bullet notes about what stood out to you about the show. Was it the acting, the sets, the technical effects, etc....? This is PURELY a note page - or even like a bullet journal, nothing formal or fancy.
