



Middle School Basketball Game Guidelines (as of 10.23.2020)

1. Capacity

- A. One-third Gym capacity will be allowed, **including all** people inside (players, coaches, cheerleaders, dance team, staff, workers, etc.)
- B. Gym bleachers will be marked off to ensure social distancing.
- C. Visiting team will have an allocated number of **(80)** tickets to sell, with the exception of Holston MS and they will have (50) to sell because of their Gym capacity.

2. Participation

- A. Basketball Teams
 1. Home and Away– 12 players may dress for game. Visiting team should come dressed.
 2. Teams should physical distance on the bench.
 3. Coaches and players will be required to wear masks on bench.
 4. Coaches that wear a face shield must also wear a mask.
- B. Cheerleaders/Dance
 1. Home and Away – 12 Cheerleaders may dress for game. Visiting team should come dressed.
 2. Cheerleaders must physical distance and wear masks.
 3. Cheerleaders may do stunts and stacks.
 4. Dance team members can perform at Home games only.

3. Tickets

- A. Tickets will be sold online (School Cash Online).
- B. Tickets will be pre-sold by each school.
- C. A limited number of tickets will be sold at the ticket gate.
- D. Tickets are refundable.
- E. KCS Employee Badges allowed for employee only for (1) admittance.
- F. KCS Athletic Passes allowed for (1) admittance.
- G. TACA & TSSAA cards are allowed for (1) admittance.

4. Concessions

- A. Only pre-packaged foods will be made available.
- B. Lines will be marked off for physical distance.
- C. All concession workers will be required to wear masks and gloves.

5. Signage

- A. Appropriate signage will be posted per TSSAA, NFHS, and KCS.

6. RED Protocol

- A. If an individual school is RED, no extracurricular activities will be allowed at that school.
- B. If the entire district is RED, no extracurricular activities will be allowed in the district.

7. Covid-19

- A. If conditions elevate in the community, KCS would make a determination on the status of winter sports. Please emphasize that all students, staff and visitors need to follow the five, core preventative Covid-19 measures:
 1. Physical distance
 2. Wear Face Masks
 3. Stay home when sick
 4. Clean and disinfect often
 5. Wash your hands
