What is the ATSA Program?

The Athletic Training Student Aide (ATSA) Program allows high school students the opportunity to observe the daily professional duties and responsibilities of an athletic trainer. This unique experience will expose students to the foundations of various sports medicine careers as well as provide them with important life skills.

ATSA learn various skills in first aid, orthopedic rehabilitation, emergency care, medical facility maintenance, healthcare administration, communication with other health care disciplines, and professionalism. Many students additionally choose to take advantage of the AT's affiliation with KOC by pursuing opportunities to shadow orthopedic physicians or physical therapists, and observe orthopedic surgeries.

- 2. Application does not ensure acceptance into the program. The number of ATSA the athletic trainer supervises each semester is at the athletic trainer's discretion and can change at any time based on other responsibilities and supervisory availability.
- 3. The time commitment required to participate in ATSA is roughly the equivalent of joining a sports team at BHS and frequently involves nights and some weekend activities.
