

STUDENT SECTION EXPECTATIONS

- Seniors are seated on the first two rows, followed by the juniors, sophomores, and then freshman in the back.
- Represent your school, your family, and yourself with sportsmanship and class.
- No profanity or rude chants (ex. No “sucks” or other inappropriate language)
- No targeting the opposing team’s players by number or name.
- No middle fingers or other inappropriate or derogatory hand gestures.
- No throwing of trash/items (water bottles! newspapers!)
- Officials are off limits!! Treat them with respect.
- Be respectful when visitors walk past our student section (barking or growling is allowed because we are Bulldogs)
- When the drum major climbs the platform, watch and cheer for our BHS band
- Be loud...Be together!!
- No confetti, corn starch, or baby powder when we are the the visiting team
 - Corn starch is okay for our 1st home game
 - NO baby powder due to allergies
- No face paint over your entire face
- No artificial noisemakers (TSSAA rule)
- LOUD when we are on defense. Quiet when we are on offense
- For indoor sporting events, no large signs and you must stay in the bleachers and off the floor.
- Section leaders will communicate with the student section about behavior. If they say something to you, you are expected to do what they tell you to do!
- If you are asked to leave by a principal, Coach Shinlever, Officer Boles or Buchannon, or any other staff member, leave without arguing so that you will be allowed to return to future events.
- If you aren’t sure, ask. Admin wants you to have fun and support our school.

- Boom box/music **ONLY** before the game (TSSAA rule)
- Trash clean up before you leave

Board Policy J-220: *Students shall not use, possess, or distribute illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages or any tobacco products or electronic cigarette/vaping devices or **be under the influence of illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages** in school buildings or on school grounds, in school vehicles or buses, or **at any school-sponsored activity at any time**, whether on or off school grounds.*
