## Frequently Asked Questions

### **How do I know if my child is scheduled to test?**

If your child is currently enrolled in English 1, English 2, US History, Biology, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry, then your child has a state test.

### **Does my child have to come into the school building to test?**

The tests are paper/pencil so students have to be physically present in the building to test.

### **What safety measures are in place for virtual students coming into the building?**

Virtual students are scheduled to test in rooms only with other virtual students. All test administrators and students are required to wear a mask during testing. Hand sanitizer and alcohol wipes will be available if needed.

### **My virtual student doesn't have transportation to school. How do they get to school for testing?**

Virtual students are allowed to ride the bus and stay for the entire school day. The student should bring his/her chromebook and headphones and plan to attend their virtual classes.

### **How does my child know where to report for testing?**

Both in-person and virtual teachers will tell their classes when and where they will be testing. Virtual students will always be assigned to either the Library or Back Commons.

### **What should my child bring to their test?**

Students will need a pencil. Students taking a math test will need a calculator (cannot be your phone or chromebook). If you do not own a calculator, we will have some to loan out on test day. Cell phones and smart watches brought into the testing room will be taken up by the test supervisor until testing is complete.

### **Are virtual students allowed to leave as soon as testing is over?**

If virtual students have transportation, they can leave when the testing session is complete.

### **What should my child do if they missed all or part of a test?**

There are four built in makeup days. If a student missed all or part of a test, they should report to the library no later than 9:00 a.m. on the next makeup day (see schedule on previous page).
