
Finding Books for Gifted Children

Sometimes, it is difficult to find books for children that read above their grade level. It can be a challenge to find appropriate books that the child finds interesting. Follow these easy steps to find the perfect book for your child:


1. Go to Lexile.com Find a Book. www.lexile.com/fab/




2. Choose your child's current grade level.



3. Next, choose a few categories that your child shows interest in.



4. Then choose the appropriate age range and Lexile level. (See below for information on Lexile levels.)



Lexile Levels

You may want to ask your child's teacher what their Lexile level is, or you can try books at increasing Lexile levels until you find the perfect level for your child. Many Gifted student's Lexile level is well beyond their typical current grade level band.

Grade	Reader Measures, Mid-Year 25th percentile to 75th percentile (IQR)
1	Up to 300L
2	140L to 500L
3	330L to 700L
4	445L to 810L
5	565L to 910L
6	665L to 1000L
7	735L to 1065L
8	805L to 1100L
9	855L to 1165L
10	905L to 1195L
11 and 12	940L to 1210L

*** A Lexile measure is a valuable piece of information about either an individual's reading ability or the difficulty of a text, like a book or magazine article. The Lexile measure is shown as a number with an "L" after it — 880L is 880 Lexile.
