The Library Media Services department is pleased to introduce our new eBook platform, MackinVIA! This platform will allow us to extend our traditional book-lending library services into the digital world, providing your family 24/7 access to great reading materials.

MackinVIA eBooks work just like regular library books, but in a digital environment. When you log in, you can search and browse for available titles, and when you find something you like, you can check it out in just a few clicks. When you're done, simply return it online and then check out some more! These eBooks are available on any internet-connected device: laptops, smart phones, iPads, Kindle Fire tablets, etc. They can be used within a regular web browser, or you can install the free MackinVIA app to download your checked-out titles and read offline.

To access these eBooks, go to <https://knoxschools.mackinvia.com/> Select your school from the drop-down menu. The username will be your child's student ID number, which starts with the letter s and is followed by a six or seven digit number. The password will be your child's Active Directory password, which is the same password they may use for other school-based online services such as Canvas, Google Drive, or to log on to Chromebooks.

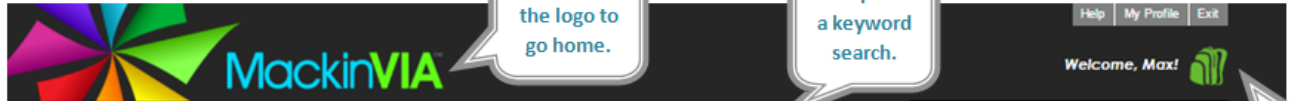
