Core academic courses such as English, science, math and social studies require a 3.0 GPA and an 18 in English and a 19 in Reading on the ACT. Non-general ed courses such as Photography, Principles of Welding, or Basketball, etc. only require a 2.0 GPA and a 13 composite on the ACT.
