Treasurer's Report:

Old Business:

- Fall Carnival moved to April 1st due to the COVID numbers in Knox County. We now have more time to get the carnival organized and get sponsors. We ideally need six sponsors. New Business:

- Ham N Goodys Thanksgiving Fundraiser. We will start selling Nov 1st and sell through to 15th but it's TBD in our October meeting.
- Pepcat Merchandise Marketing. We have kid's long sleeve shirts, kid's hoodies, and earrings now! A flyer will go out soon about those. We will have long sleeve socks, too.
- *Grounds Day*. Vote on 2 weeks before fall break. October 2nd and alternative date of 23rd for rain day. We would like to have Adopt-A-Bed for maintenance of the beds this year. We will discuss that later, too.

Principal's Report:

Mr. Angel was thankful for the funds the teachers got at the beginning of the school year to help set up their classrooms.
