Morning Drop Off

Please help us develop your children's independence by allowing them to walk down the halls and into their classrooms by themselves in the morning as soon as they are able. The morning is not a good time for a drop-in chat with the teacher since they begin supervising students right at 7:30 A.M. Please let them give you their full attention by scheduling a conference or requesting a phone conference. We want to partner with you to provide the best possible education for your child!

Afternoon Pick Up

If the pick up person for your child does not bring the green car ID tag that hangs on the rearview mirror with them to pick up your children, they will need to bring their personal photo ID into the office in order to pick up your children.

Please pull close to the curb when dropping off or picking up so the Student Leadership Team student doesn't have to step off the curb.

Please teach your child to fasten his/her own car seat belt. That will speed up the line if you don't have to get out of the car to do that.
