COLLEGE VISIT EXPECTATIONS

Upperclassmen are allowed five (5) college visit days: 2 during the junior year and 3 during the senior year.

Additional days may be approved by your grade level principal.

The procedure below must be followed in order for the college visit to not count against any grade/attendance incentives. Students are responsible for all required make-up work.

- 1. Prior to the visit, complete an online **Bearden High School College Visit Form**.
- 2. During the visit, secure documentation of the visit from the college.
- 3. Within five (5) school days following the visit, return documentation of the college visit to the College & Career Center.
- 4. Many colleges have an official absence-from-school letter. If a college does not provide their own, then have a college representative complete the Bearden College Visit Verification Letter. Return this to the **College & Career Center.**
