Welcome to Third Grade


• We are a dedicated team of 18 third grade teachers. We are self-contained; however, we switch for Science & Social Studies between team teachers.

ELA:

- Fluency phonics instruction & intervention when needed
- Spelling phonics and spelling patterns assessed using dictation sentences
- Writing narrative, opinion, explanatory
- Comprehension Transition from "Learn to Read" to "Read to Learn"



MATH:

- Facts/fluency memorizing multiplication facts are <u>essential</u> to your child's success in math.
- Multi-step Word Problems use of problem-solving strategies are introduced, increasing the rigor of math curriculum.

MATH:

• Topics:

- -Operations & Algebraic Thinking Part 1 multiplication & division
- -Number & Operations in Base Ten rounding, fluently add & subtract within 1,000
- -Operations & Algebraic Thinking using understanding of concepts of multiplication & division and apply this to word problems)
- -Number & Operations Fractions (parts of whole, number lines, equivalent, comparing)
- -Measurement & Data time, liquid volume and mass, graphs, area, & perimeter
- -Geometry shapes & attributes



SCIENCE:

- Opportunities for hands-on, minds-on learning in science class
- Topics: Life Sciences, Physical Sciences,
 - Earth & Space Sciences
- Engineering & Design

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- Topics: World Geography, US/TN Geography, Economics,
- Early American & TN history
- Indigenous Peoples through European Exploration (prior to 1585)
- Early North American Settlements (1585-1600s)
