

Crossroads Christian Church is offering this scholarship to graduating high school seniors who are performing well academically, who demonstrate character in their life, and who will be enrolling in a postsecondary education institution (university, community college, or other two year training program) completing a degree or training program, in the career fields of music, math/sciences or health sciences. This is a one-time scholarship provided to assist candidates with the purchase of books and/or other academic materials in their programs.

ELIGIBILITY/APPLICATION: The Applicant Must:

- 1) **See high school guidance counselor** to show proof he/she is making satisfactory progress towards high school graduation at the end of the current school year, or has successfully completed the curriculum at an accredited high school since the end of the previous school year, maintaining a 3.0 GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale. You must enroll at a postsecondary institution by Fall semester 2020 to receive this scholarship.
- 2) **Submit two letters of recommendation with the attached application form:** a letter from your teacher and one from a mentor emphasizing the applicant's special accomplishments, leadership skills and character. Both letters are required to confirm that you have really accomplished or achieved what you say you have done and or have observed your hard work and character, church activities, community service, high school accomplishments, leadership skills, or any other factors that make you special or unique.
- 3) **Submit a One Page Essay Attached to the Application Form: This is your personal essay expressing in your own words a) why you want to go to college and receive more training in your chosen career field of music or math/science and b) how this scholarship can help you.** The Crossroads Christian Church Scholarship Committee will select the best candidates for the scholarship based upon your essay and letters of recommendation. Your essay will be evaluated for overall best presentation including (your spelling, grammar, how well you express yourself and neatness). The essay must be Typed (handwritten essays will not be accepted).

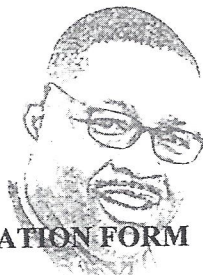
DEADLINE DATE FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION:
