B & W Y-12 Scholarship:

For graduating seniors from ten counties, including Anderson, studying science; for example, bio-medical engineering, environmental science, physics, chemistry, or pre-engineering at Roane State Community College, Pellissippi State Community College, Walters State Community College, Maryville College, Tennessee Technological University or the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. **Note: This scholarship is NOT intended for those seeking to be health care professionals or educators.**

Scholarship Amount: \$1,400 one-time award for one year

Butterfly Fund Memorial Scholarship

To assist graduating high school seniors and current college students pursuing a career in a broad variety of fields within pediatric oncology. **Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.**

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000-\$2,000 one-time award for one year

Harold W. Canfield Memorial Scholarship

For graduating seniors from 10 counties, including Knox, pursuing an undergraduate degree from an accredited not-for-profit college or university. Participation in the Knoxville Track Club (**NOT** Knoxville Youth Athletics-KYA) required.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year

Cherish the Child Legacy Scholarship

To provide scholarship assistance to eligible students, age 25 or younger, who are or were foster care participants or who received services from Smoky Mountain Children's Home.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,800-\$3,600 one-time award for one year

Gail Clay Scholarship **RETURNING SCHOLARSHIP!**

For a spouse or child of a full-time, non-exempt employee of the University of Tennessee or other state-supported, public, higher education institution located in ETF's 25county service area. Graduating high school seniors or current college/university students may apply.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000 per year for four years

Gordon W. and Agnes P. Cobb Scholarship

For graduating seniors of high schools located in Blount, Loudon, or Knox County, or current college/university students who graduated from a high school located in Blount, Loudon, or Knox County, pursuing a 4-year undergraduate degree in health care and/or a medical-related field.

Scholarship Amount: \$10,000 per year award for up to four years

James K. Goldston Cybersecurity Scholarship

Graduating high school seniors, college/university students and adult students pursuing undergraduate programs of study in computer science, computer engineering, cyber science, cybersecurity, or enrollment in an [*NSA National Center for Academic Excellence in Cybersecurity*](#) program. **Recipients and former applicants may reapply for this scholarship.**

Scholarship Amount: \$1,700 one-time award for one year

Michael David Greene Scholarship

For Farragut High School (FHS) graduating seniors who participated in the FHS band program.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 per year for two years

Brittany Johnson Memorial Scholarship **NEW SCHOLARSHIP!**

Established in memory of Brittany Johnson to assist graduating high school seniors and current college students pursuing an undergraduate degree, with preference given to female basketball players attending or planning to attend Maryville College

Scholarship Amount: TBD

Barbara G. Kirkpatrick Memorial Scholarship

To assist single parent students pursuing a four-year undergraduate degree at East Tennessee State University. Graduating high school seniors, current college students, GED recipients, or returning adult students may apply.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000 one-time award for one year

Knox Central Class of '50 Alumni Association Scholarship

For graduating seniors of Central High School.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500 one-time award for one year

Knox Central Class of '50 Alumni Association-Strader Scholarship

For graduating seniors of Central High School.

Scholarship Amount: \$3,500 per year for up to four years

Knoxville Football Officials Association Scholarship

To benefit graduating seniors from high schools served by the Knoxville Football Official Association (which includes Austin-East High School, Bearden High School, Carter High School, Central High School, Christian Academy of Knoxville, Farragut High School, Fulton High School, Gibbs High School, Grace Christian Academy, Halls High School, Hardin Valley Academy, Karns High School, Knoxville Catholic High School, Powell High School, South-Doyle High School, Tennessee School for the Deaf, Webb School of Knoxville, or West High School), who are members of and/or are directly associated with (e.g. cheerleader, dance team member, team manager, team trainer) their high school football team.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,500 per year award for up to four years

Brandy Maples Memorial Scholarship

For graduating seniors of Carter High School.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 per year award for up to two years

Elizabeth Hope Marlette Memorial Scholarship

To benefit students pursuing a post-secondary education in a medical-related field.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year

Joe R. and Kathy K. May Scholarship **NEW SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA!**

To provide financial assistance to first generation students from Anderson, Blount, Grainger, Jefferson, Knox, Loudon, Roane, Sevier, or Union counties in TN, with preference given to West High School students in Knox County, who may not display the highest scholastic rankings, yet possess potential and motivation, as they pursue their dream of obtaining a college education.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000 one-time award for one year

Lawrence Strader Boy Scouts of America Scholarship

For graduating seniors from 21 counties, including Knox, who are currently registered members of Boy Scouts of America, Great Smoky Mountain Council, with a minimum of three years participation as a Boy Scout. **Please note:** Female applicants welcome.

Scholarship Amount: \$3,000 per year award for up to four years

Valkyrie-Thor Scholarship in Theatre Arts Fund

To assist graduating high school seniors and college students from ETF's 25-county region studying theatre arts at Pellissippi State Community College, Roane State Community College, University of Tennessee, Knoxville, or Maryville College.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year

Debbie Van Cleave Scholarship

The scholarship is intended to benefit legally blind students from ETF's 25-county service area to pursue higher education. Applicants must be blind, with vision of 20/200 or less in the better eye **after** correction and/or a visual field reduced to 20 degrees or less. Graduating high school seniors, current college/university students, GED recipients, and returning adult students may apply.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year

Gregory Weber Computer Science Scholarship

To benefit graduating high school seniors from a Knox County high school pursuing a bachelor's degree in computer science.

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000 one-time award for one year

Haley Van Pelt Scholarship

To benefit students of any age seeking post-secondary education who have a permanent intellectual or developmental disability and/or functional impairment.

Scholarship Amount: \$1,000 one-time award for one year

Lew and Janice Weems Scholarship **NEW SCHOLARSHIP!**

Established to benefit students of all ages from Blount, Knox, and Washington counties with financial need, with preference given to first generation students and students who are parents.

Note: Part-time or full-time enrollment permitted.
