2018 Lois Kelly Scholarship Program

Named after longtime member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, the **Lois Kelly Scholarship Program** provides financial assistance to eligible women who are planning to attend or who are currently enrolled in a two- or four-year



accredited institution of higher learning. Mrs. Kelly (1908-2012) was an active member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, Nu Zeta chapter, for 79 years. At a banquet celebrating Mrs. Kelly's 100th birthday, the Nu Zeta Chapter of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, founded in 1935 in Knoxville, TN, honored Mrs. Kelly by establishing a scholarship designed to support women who were in pursuit of degrees of higher learning in the area of education. Since that time, however, this scholarship program has expanded to honor women across all academic disciplines. Throughout her 104 years of life, among other roles, Mrs. Kelly served as an elementary school teacher, an office manager for her husband's dental practice, a leader in the civil rights movement, a tutor with the Boys and Girls Club, and an active member of her church and community. Alongside a host of other accomplishments, Mrs. Kelly received the 2010 Covenant

Health Platinum Award for her dedication to her community and the education of its members, and in 2008, she was honored by the Honorable John J. Duncan, Jr. in the Tennessee House of Representatives.

It is in remembrance of our beloved sorority member that we open this year's application cycle. Applicants are invited to apply for one of three financial awards: graduate/professional, undergraduate, and youth. Details regarding applicant requirements, the application process, and important dates to remember are found below.

Eligibility

To be considered for a Lois Kelly Scholarship, female applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Identify currently as a high school senior who is accepted to attend an accredited college or university in Knoxville and/or the surrounding area or an undergraduate or graduate/professional student who is currently enrolled in an accredited college or university in Knoxville and/or the surrounding area (proof of enrollment and/or acceptance will be required).
- 2. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (unweighted) on a 4.0 scale
- 3. Submit a completed application (details below)

Scholarships are in the amount of \$500 (youth and undergraduate) or \$1000 (graduate/professional) and will be awarded one (1) time only, payable directly to the school (undergraduate and youth) or to the recipient via check (graduate/professional).



Application Guidelines

For an application to be considered complete, all applicants must submit:

- 1. A completed application.
- 2. An **official transcript** from the current school of enrollment. Transcripts must be mailed directly from the school, college, or university in a sealed envelope. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.
- 3. Two (2) **letters of recommendation** from persons who are familiar with your academic and leadership abilities. One letter *must* come from a teacher/professor/faculty advisor/professional supervisor (as applicable). For members of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated or an Auxiliary of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, one letter must come from the sponsoring chapter's president (for graduate members) or advisor (for undergraduate and auxiliary members).
- 4. An essay of at least 150 but no more than 500 words describing an influential woman in your life who has challenged or motivated you to succeed. How has this woman impacted your educational pursuits? What characteristics of Finer Womanhood does this woman exhibit, and how do you seek to exhibit these characteristics in your academic career? The essay should be typed and double-spaced on a separate page. For graduate/ professional student applicants only, in addition to this essay, a description of your research and/or future career endeavors is also required. This additional essay should be no more than two (2) double-spaced pages typed.
