Enclosed is information relative to the Stan and Thelma Plumlee Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded each year, by the Tennessee Housing Association, as an honor to the late Stan Plumlee.

Mr. Plumlee was a pioneer of our industry. He was a man of upstanding character, tremendous compassion and dedication, a friend to all, and was an avid proponent of higher education. We honor his legacy to our industry, by continuing to further his desire to ensure deserving individuals have the opportunity of an education. This is a four-year scholarship with a total value of \$8,000, provided the student remains in school.

To qualify, a recipient must be associated with the manufactured housing industry in some way; either by living in a manufactured home, working in the industry, or by having a close relative who works in the manufactured housing industry. The student must attend a Tennessee college, university or trade/technical school. Additionally, a stated level of GPA must be maintained. The enclosed will provide specifics.



As a note, in years past, we have had very few individuals apply, whose intent is to attend a trade or technical school. We value these students, and understand they need to be appreciated for their specific talents. Education on any level is important, and qualified trades and labor workers are a vital foundation of our industry's existence, and to our continued success. Please encourage your trades and labor students and/or technical bound students, to apply for this scholarship as well.

We respectfully ask you to disseminate this information to the appropriate educational advisors within your school district. The deadline to receive completed applications is **March 8, 2019**. The selected scholarship recipient will be notified in **April 2019**, through their educational advisor or alternate school official. 2019 STAN & THELMA PLUMLEE SCHOLARSHIP
Scholarship Requirements and Information
(College, University or Trade Schools)

Scholarship applicants **MUST** be associated with the manufactured or modular housing industry, to be considered. For example, living in a manufactured or modular home; or working in the manufactured or modular industry; or by having a close relative who works in the manufactured or modular industry. (As defined on the application.)

1. In order for a student to receive the entire Stan & Thelma Plumlee Scholarship Award of \$8,000, the following criteria must be followed:
 - Must have graduated from a Tennessee High School (public, private, parochial) or equivalent (GED).
 - Must be accepted by a Tennessee institute of higher learning.
 - The institute of higher learning **must be a Tennessee** public or private university or college, a junior college, or an accredited trade or technical school.
2. Scholarship is for a maximum of four years, up to the maximum of \$8000. Tuition is paid in increments of \$1,000 per semester, as long as the following criteria are met:
 - Must be a full time student, as defined by the institute of choice.
 - **Student** must notify their institute of higher learning, an official transcript for the prior semester shall be submitted, along with an invoice for payment and a stated verification the student is enrolled in the upcoming semester. This shall be completed in order for the scholarship to be renewed on the per semester scheduled disbursement.
 - Following the below stated schedule, the transcript must be accompanied with an invoice, printed on school letterhead, along with a statement which verifies the student is enrolled in the upcoming semester, for each semester payment request which is submitted and received by the Tennessee Housing Association (THA) Board of Directors. (Some variances will apply for **Trade Schools**.)
 - For the fall academic session, documentation must be submitted from the institution by July, preceding attendance to the fall semester.
 - For the spring academic session, documentation must be submitted from the institution by December, preceding attendance to the spring semester.
 - If we do not receive the invoice, transcript and enrollment verification by the above listed dates, a forfeiture of funds may occur for that semester.
 - ***It is the student's responsibility to remind the institution of this requirement, and to follow up with the institution's assigned coordinator, to ensure compliance has been completed.***
3. Criteria for Revocation of Scholarship:
 - Falls below good standing.
 - Not making appropriate progress.
 - Placed on academic or social probation.
