



## SCHOLARSHIPS, FELLOWSHIPS, AND AWARDS FOR FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS ENTERING FALL 2022

Scholarships are awarded based on academic information, student interest, student leadership and/or talent. In instances where a student qualifies for more than one scholarship, the student will receive the largest scholarship for which they are eligible. In cases where students are eligible to receive more than one award, the total cannot exceed tuition and fees.

<b>Kiwanis Scholarship</b>	Awarded to a student from Blount County, Maryville City or Alcoa City Schools. The recipient will be an active member of the Circle K organization at MC.	<b>\$3,000</b> Non-renewable
<b>Equal Chance for Education Scholarship</b>	Awarded to IO DACA or undocumented students living in East Tennessee. 3.0+ GPA and have lived in Tennessee for the last 12 months.	<b>\$6,250 per year</b> <b>MC ECE Scholarship</b> based on merit. Renewable with 2.0 GPA
<b>Brahams Scholarship</b>	The Brahams Scholarship is for students who demonstrate a passion for service but don't meet the financial need requirements for the Bonner Scholarship. Brahams scholars will participate in a significant amount of Bonner programming.	<b>\$4,000</b> per year Renewable with 2.75 GPA
<b>Isaac Anderson Fellowship for Church Leadership</b>	Student leaders wanting to explore their goals of work and calling in light of their Christian faith. Minimum combined 26+ ACT or 1240+ SAT or 81+ CLT and 3.5+ GPA.	<b>\$2,500</b> per year Renewable with 2.75 GPA
<b>Chapel Fellowship</b>	Students with experience and interest in leading worship, especially music in services. Recipients will be active participants in chapel leadership through the Center for Campus Ministry.	<b>\$2,000</b> per year Renewable with 2.0 GPA
<b>Church &amp; College Fellowship</b>	Active members of the Presbyterian Church (USA) or the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Recipients are committed to providing three hours per week of volunteer service to local Presbyterian churches.	<b>\$1,000</b> per year Renewable with 2.0 GPA
<b>ALANA Cultural Diversity Award</b>	Underrepresented students with leadership potential, academic promise, and the ability to contribute to cultural diversity. Recipients required to participate in related campus organizations.	<b>Up to \$2,000</b> per year Renewable with 2.0 GPA
<b>Instrumental Music Ensemble Award</b>	Non-music majors based on individual talent. Recipients required to participate in a related music ensemble.	<b>Up to \$2,000</b> per year Renewable with continued involvement in a music ensemble with 2.5 GPA
<b>Choral Award</b>	Non-music majors. Prefer at least two years prior participation in a high school chorus. Recipients required to participate in a choral ensemble.	<b>Up to \$2,000</b> per year Renewable with continued involvement in a choral ensemble with 2.5 GPA
<b>MC Playhouse Award</b>	Non-theatre majors. Prefer at least two years of prior participation in theatre productions. Recipients are required to participate in theatre productions.	<b>Up to \$2,000</b> per year Renewable with continued involvement in theatre productions with 2.5 GPA.
<b>MC First Award</b>	Students from families where their parents/guardians did not complete a four-year college degree.	<b>\$1,000</b> per year Renewable with continued involvement in campus organization.
