Enrolling Your Child in Kindergarten

All of our 4-year old students need to enroll in Kindergarten on Tuesday, April 12th. It is important to know where your child is zoned so that you can go to that school on that evening to register your child. You will need your child's birth certificate, immunization and physical information, and proof of residence. If you are not the child's birth mother, you will need to show custody papers. Please let us know if you have any questions.



Mandatory Parent Orientation

Just like the beginning of this year, we will have a Mandatory Parent Orientation at the beginning of the next school year for parent/guardian to attend. The dates are Wednesday, August 3rd for 3-year olds and Friday, August 5th for 4-year olds. We will begin at 6:00 p.m. and end at 8:00 p.m. Please add these dates to your calendar. We want to give you plenty of time to plan ahead. There will be no make up sessions for these orientations. If for some reason, you can't make it on your child's age level night, you can come on the other night. Any student without representation on any one of the nights will be moved to the waiting list. We want to make sure our expectations for the school year are clear at the beginning of the year, so that you and your child will have a productive year.
