



Did you know?



In our last newsletter, we shared how reading with your child for 20 minutes a day can expose your child to over a million words a year! This month, we want to share information about vocabulary. Did you know that children's vocabulary in preschool has a direct affect on their reading comprehension in upper grades? In PreK, we focus a lot on listening comprehension. Listening comprehension exposes our children to new words, new concepts, and new experiences. It builds background knowledge that will help them make connections to higher learning. As you read with your child, ask him/her questions about the pictures that are in the story. Ask questions about what is happening in the story. Repeat some of the vocabulary and characters' names from the story and encourage your child to use some of the same words that are in the story. You will see amazing results in your child's listening comprehension skills, as you prepare for them to become successful readers.
