Dear Hardin Valley Academy Senior Parent or Guardian:

We will be giving seniors their End of Course (hereafter known as EOC) exams or final projects Monday, May 12 through Wednesday, May14. The schedule for EOC exams or final projects is listed below. 7 a.m. classes will complete their exams/projects on Monday May 12. Seniors will not meet for 7 a.m. classes after this date. All classes will meet at their regularly scheduled times.

If your child is exempt from an exam or final project, he/she will receive a permission slip requiring a parent signature. These must be returned to classroom teachers by Friday, May 9, 2025. All Chromebooks must be returned to the student's study hall teacher before the last day of school.

We know that some seniors will choose to leave school after second period on Tuesday May 13. <u>If students choose to leave early,</u> <u>they must provide their own transportation.</u> <u>Students choosing this option must leave campus immediately following second</u> <u>period. Please make advanced arrangements for transportation. School buses will not run until 3:30 p.m. Those students who</u> <u>stay for the afternoon classes must follow our normal bell schedule. Additionally, if your child has met all his/her academic</u> <u>and financial obligations and returned assigned Chromebook, he/she is exempt from school from Wednesday May 14 through</u> <u>Wednesday, May 21.</u>
