

## West Haven 2018-2019 School Plan Prioritized Goals

The West Haven School Plan highlights our areas of strengths and opportunities. Goals and action steps are included in the plan and measurement criteria. You may access the complete plan at https://eplan.tn.gov.

- 1. To increase the number of students On Grade Level or Above in Reading/Language Arts by 5% to get to 24.3% on the TCAP exam for grades 3-5.
- 2. To increase the number of students On Grade Level or Above in Math by 4.8% to get to 28.2% on the TCAP exam for grades 3-5.
- 3. To increase the number of students On Grade Level or Above in Science by 3.7% to get to 44.4% on the TCAP exam for grades 3-5.
