Endorsement Requirements (Beginning with the Class of 2021)

In addition to meeting grade level Knox County graduation requirements, Academy Endorsement Requirements include:

- 1. 30 Credits (4 of which support a progression towards area of endorsement, see below)
- 2. Minimum 3.0 GPA, minimum one course must be honors/AP/Dual Enrollment
- 3. 50 hours of service learning over 9th-12th grades (30 prior to conclusion of 11th)
- 4. 'C' or better in Work Based Learning or AP Capstone Program or Academic Research
- 5. Speech is strongly suggested and may possibly be used to count as one of the four courses for endorsement
- 6. 30 hours job-shadowing (waived if completing Work Based Learning)
- 7. Presentation to Flight Time
- 8. Showcase Night Evening Community Poster Presentation

- 3 additional Science electives: Choose from the following: (Honors Biology II, AP Biology, Honors Chemistry II, AP Chemistry, Microbiology, VIST, AP Physics, Physics, Botany and Zoology)
