1. Academic honesty and integrity statement:

2. Honor Code Statement:

- 1. Copying verbatim all or part of another's written work;
- 2. Using phrases, figures, or illustrations without citing the source;

- 4. Using all or part of a literary plot, poem, or film without attributing the work to its creator."

For all coursework (assignments, exams, projects, etc.), students agree to the following compulsory statements:

- My work is my own and I have neither cheated nor plagiarized anything with my name on it.
- I agree to neither participate, either directly or as a bystander, in any cheating or plagiarism and will discourage others from doing so.
- I understand and agree that if I am ever suspected of or guilty of breaking the Bearden High School honor code, repercussions can include a failing grade or other punishment as set forth by my teacher and school administration.

3. Staff Responsibility Statement:

Staff will apply consequences appropriate to each individual circumstance of student dishonesty. Consequences may include, but are not limited to:

- A zero or reduced grade for the assignment
- Opportunity to redo the assignment at a reduced point value
- Notification to parent or other form of parent/teacher contact.
- Student referral to detention or suspension
- Loss of membership from leadership or honor societies
- Revocation or refusal of teacher recommendation letters to colleges.
- Any appropriate combination of the above or other that is deemed appropriate by administration.
