

2020-2021 Math Placement Test Request

The purpose of a math placement test is to determine the appropriate academic placement for your child for middle school.

- A student is allowed to take only **one (1) math placement test during middle school.**
- Once the math placement test is administered and the appropriate academic placement is determined, the appropriate academic progression is set.
- To be considered for advancement in math, the student must score a **minimum of 85%** on the placement test.
- At the completion of the math placement test, the student will be enrolled in the appropriate academic level of math indicated and a schedule change will be made if necessary. This schedule change may result in multiple class changes and/or a change in pod.
