OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY:

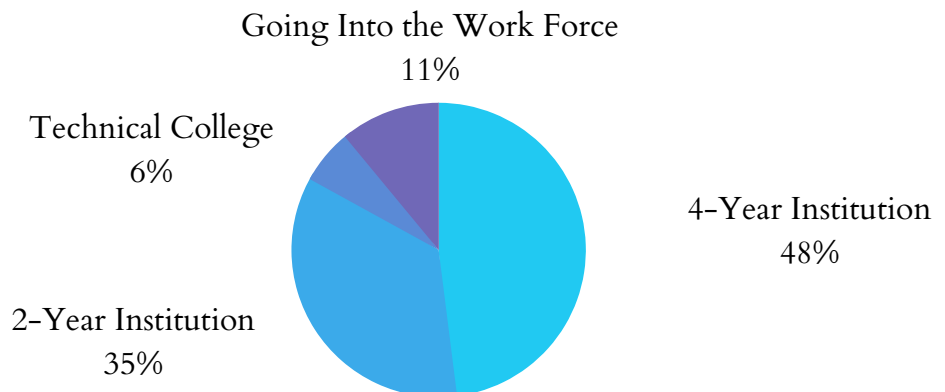
Austin East is one of 16 high schools within Knox County located in the heart of East Knoxville. It is the only Performing Arts Magnet High School in the district, offering continuous quality dance, musical, audio production, advanced art, and theatre programs. As students excel in the performing arts, Austin East also seeks to provide all students with a quality education to ensure students are college ready and life prepared. We are a comprehensive 4-year, urban high school with approximately 745 students in attendance. There is a strong history of pride and accomplishments that makes the school a jewel in the community.

OUR CURRICULUM:

Our academic progress is organized in a 4 x 4 block schedule. Four credits per semester is the course load offered to students. Each day consists of four, 90 minute classes. A minimum of 28 credits is required for graduation. We offer 7 Advanced Placement courses, 9 honors and 5 dual credit courses as well as many different elective options, including an AVID program.

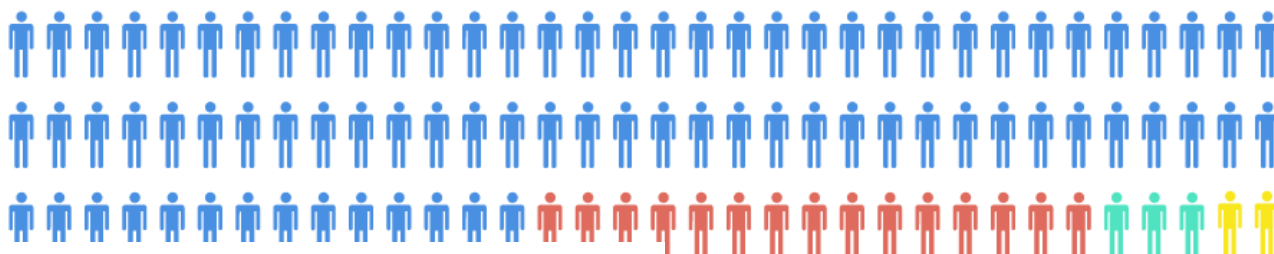
DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES: Calculus, English Composition (ENG 1010), Web Technology (WEB 1600), and others are available off campus.
