Last Year

- 4 semester-long classes at approx. 90 min. each on M, T, R, F
- Classes on W may be year-long or semester-long and last approx. 80 min.
- School ends at 3:30 PM each day and begins at 8:30 AM M,T,R,F.
- On W, school begins at 9:30 AM; buses will still run on time. Spaces will be available in the school for students arriving via bus to stay until classes begin.

Requesting a Schedule Change

- The schedule change request form will be available on the HHS counseling website (<https://tinyurl.com/pyt33w7y>) and “Class of…” Canvas pages beginning the morning of July 30th.
- The form will close and schedule change requests will no longer be accepted as of 8:30 AM on Friday, August 13th
- Schedule changes will be reviewed and processed by Friday, August 20th. Please allow counselors through this date to complete eligible changes.

Requesting a Schedule Change

Follow the schedule listed in Aspen at all times, even if the schedule change has not yet been fulfilled. Please check Aspen frequently if you have submitted a schedule change request. Counselors will contact you directly only if your request is denied or additional information is needed.

Criteria for Approval of Request

- Class changes should be based on the following criteria:
 - Level placement (e.g. a student was placed into a CP-level course but wishes to take an honors-level course**)
 - Technology or administrative error (student was misplaced in a course he/she has already passed)
 - Student placed in a course he/she did not request and does not want to take
- Do NOT request class changes based on the following criteria:
 - Classes will not be changed based on a student's request for a specific teacher.
 - Electives that were requested by students in the spring (as primary or alternate requests) will not be changed.

Requesting a Schedule Change

All schedule change requests may not be fulfilled. Changes are subject to student requests in the spring, availability, and counselor/administrator approval. Students may be required to take a course they did not request based on course availability and student schedule flexibility.

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
