REGULAR ELECTIVES

CLUBS, TEAMS, AND ACTIVITIES (ACADEMIC)

ENRICHMENT OPPORTUNITIES

- **US History Remediation**: Students enrolled in US History may take this course to receive extra work time and help with assignments. (*Teacher to be determined*)
