Jake Poole led the way for the Dogs with 28 points. Nelson Karnowski added 12 and Noah Karnowski scored 8.


# Bearden High School Dance Team Wins TSSAA Double Title State Championship

Congratulations to the Bearden High School Dance Team on winning TSSAA double state titles in both Medium Varsity Pom and Medium Varsity Jazz in Murfreesboro on December 7<sup>th</sup>. This is the team's 11<sup>th</sup> TSSAA state title and 7<sup>th</sup> consecutive jazz title. This 7-peat win is history making for the Bearden High School dance program.

The team will travel to Orlando in January to compete at the UDA National Dance Competition. Bearden holds two National dance titles currently – one in Large Varsity Gameday and one in Medium Varsity Pom.

Bearden Dance is recognized locally, regionally and nationally as one of the top ranked teams in the country.
