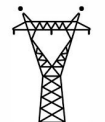


Young Scholars Program

ASVAB gives your child the confidence to map out a post-secondary plan that aligns with their individual skills and interests.

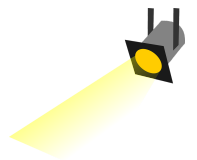

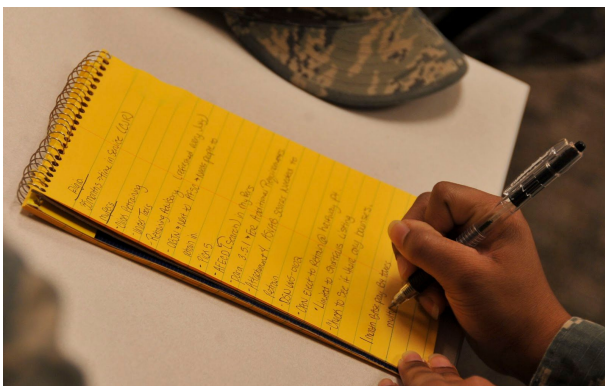
