NeoTerra competed against many firms and won first place in the Tennessee Business Plan Competition. This secured them the opportunity to compete against many more highly-competitive firms at the national level, which will be held in New York this coming April. The six-person presentation team and the rest of the company have been working relentlessly to make this dream a reality. Their success, however, does not stop there! The company was also honored to receive first place in the Advanced Website competition. Web-designer Marly Delaura hand-coded NeoTerra's entire website without the use of any website templates. Additionally, two employees, Catherine Obear and Leilu Sharp, competed against over 200 students and took home both the first and second place rank in the Intuit Innovation Challenge: a new concept where students are placed in randomized groups and asked to solve and present a difficult business challenge.
