



## PROGRAM OVERVIEW



The Knox County Schools Child Find department works in partnership with families of children ages 3-5 who have concerns about their child's educational development. A team of specialists work collaboratively to determine if a child is eligible for special education support. Educational needs are determined through parent input, observations and child evaluations.

Areas evaluated may include, but are not limited to, speech and language, hearing, vision, motor, cognitive, social/emotional and adaptive development.

If a child is found eligible for services, an individualized plan will be developed to support the child's educational needs.
