Medium-High Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modifying accounts or privileges on any school computer. • Erasing for formatting or restoring device. • Sending threatening/harassing messages. • Getting on inappropriate websites – porn ... sites that would be blocked for CIPA reasons. • Deleting browser history 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day User • OSS • Device Removal <p>Parent-Student Conference</p>
High Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accessing Secure Content such as Gradebook, Star, Sped Info, etc through either physical or network means. • Enabling or teaching other students to access secure content. • Physically accessing a teacher computer without permission. • Creating, distributing, or knowingly downloading/saving pornographic or illegal content. • Conducting illegal activities or hacking on the computer or network. • Stealing student computer or accessories. • Selling/pawning computer. • Purposely damaging a computer. • Taking or transmitting inappropriate photo's / video's of self. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Disciplinary Hearing • Long term OSS <p>Parent-Student Conference</p>
