Getting on inappropriate websites - violence sites that would be blocked for CIPA reasons. Modifying computer settings to make it unusable (temporarily). Not keeping laptops protected - case, backpack. Blatantly repetitively playing games or deliberately being off-task during instructional time. Medium-High Level	 Modifying accounts or privileges on any school computer. Erasing for formatting or restoring device. Sending threatening/harassing messages. High Level	 Accessing Secure Content such as Gradebook, Star, Sped Info, etc through either physical or network means. Enabling or teaching other students to access secure content. Physically accessing a teacher computer without permission. Creating, distributing, or knowingly downloading/saving pornographic or illegal content. Conducting illegal activities or hacking on the computer or network. Stealing student computer or accessories. Selling/pawning computer. Purposely damaging a computer.
