SCHOOL GOALS

We are still focusing on three goals for our school. They are reading, math and Chronic Absenteeism.

Our three main goals this year are:

- Increasing student growth in reading as measured by our Universal Screener that is given three times a year.
- Increasing student growth in math as measured by our Universal Screener that is given three times a year.
- Decreasing our number of absenteeism at our school, especially chronic absenteeism.

According to the state of Tennessee research shows:

Tennessee students who are chronically absent in kindergarten are 15 percentage points less likely to reach proficiency in either 3rd grade math or ELA. Nationally, four out of five students who miss more than 10% of both kindergarten and first grade are unable to read on grade-level by third grade.
