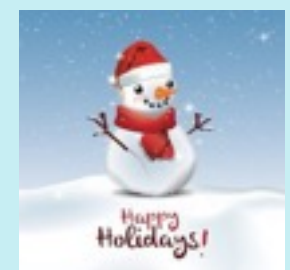
CELL PHONES:
