Pitches: GAB

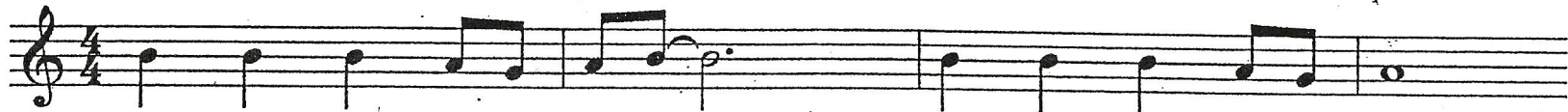


**dotted half note = 3 beats**  
(A dot after a note gets half the value of that note and makes it that much longer.)



**quarter rest = 1 beat of silence**

## THE TROLLEY SONG

"Zing, zing, zing," went my heart strings, — For the mo - ment I saw him I fell. —

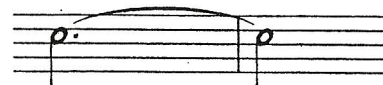
### new rhythm:



**two eighth notes = 1 beat**

(Each single eighth note gets 1/2 beat.)

A tie  is a curved line which connects notes of the same pitch. Only the first note is played and then it is held for the total value of the connected notes.

**new rhythm:**  whole note = 4 beats
