

# Bearden High School AP Exam Information - SY 2021-2022 updated 1/25/22

#### GENERAL TESTING INFORMATION

All AP Exams will be pencil & paper based (no online exams).

All AP Exams will be administered OFF CAMPUS with the exception of the AP Human Geography exam.

The Off Campus location is To Be Determined

Students must sit for the AP Exam before \*5 points will be added to their AP course grade.

\*Seniors who were in Fall AP courses and who submitted the "AP Senior Statement of Intent" form to their Fall AP Teachers and who registered and paid for an AP exam will get the 5 points to be temporarily added to a Senior's transcript. Should the Senior later decide not to test, the 5 points will be removed from their transcript.

## AP REGISTRATION IS A TWO-STEP PROCESS DONE AT TWO (2) DIFFERENT SITES:

- 1) Activate your AP Exam by going to <u>http://myap.collegeboard.org</u> and submit the Join Code (access code) for each AP Class (your AP teacher has the code/access code for your class)
  - This step is commonly referred to as "Joining your AP Classroom"
  - If you don't Join the AP Classroom, you will NOT have an exam ordered
  - When you first *Join the AP Classroom* you will get a message that appears that you have registered for the AP Test; but an AP Test registration in full is not valid until you also *Pay for the exam* (which is step two)

# AP EXAM PAYMENT ON THE APTS SITE

- Exams cost is \$96 per exam and \$144 for Capstone (Seminar & Research)
  - Late registration fee is \$40
- You must pay for your exam in order for it to be ordered. If you do not pay, your exam will not be ordered.

- Students may submit a *Financial Hardship* request to have the AP Exam fee reduced.
