

Per Knox County Schools (KCS) written policy:

- TN Department of Health Certificate of Immunization ("Shot Record") is due immediately upon enrollment.
- Physical examination is due in 30 days.
 Paperwork proving your child received an exam can be dated any time between August 8, 2017 and now. Paperwork is due by Monday, September 10, 2018.
 - If we do not receive a shot record and proof of physical exam by the deadline, your child will not be allowed to attend school until the documents are received (per policy of Knox County Schools)
 - o If you gave us this last year, you do not need to provide it again.
- Remember to keep your phone numbers, for parent/guardian and emergency contacts, updated with the office. If there is an emergency, we must be able to speak with you!
- If your child has serious food allergies, insect allergies, or needs medication given at school (as-needed or daily), please have your child's doctor fill in the necessary KCS forms as soon as possible. Forms are available from the nurse or front office.
 - Medication MUST BE signed in with the front office by parent/guardian, and we MUST have medication administration orders completed and signed by the prescribing doctor in order to give medication. Children CANNOT carry medication to school.
- Our cafeteria cannot provide food substitutions or provide soy milk, almond milk, or Lactaid unless we have the proper KCS forms completed and signed by your child's doctor.
 - If your child needs another kind of milk or has specific food requirements, you are welcome to pack his/her lunch and snack.

- If your child has a fever, diarrhea, throws up, pink eye, or undiagnosed rash, for the health and safety of students and staff, your child must go home.
 - o If your child is sent home by the nurse due to illness, the next day will be an excused absence. Some illnesses require a doctor's note to return to school.
