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Primary GT Services in K-2 Elementary Classrooms

We are excited to be serving your teachers and your advanced students through our new GT initiative this 2017-18 school year. Some services GT Primary Coaches have been experimenting with are modeling, co-planning and co-teaching, teaching advanced small groups in classrooms, planning and teaching Core Extension enrichment groups, and creating and providing Tier 1 resources. Currently, in schools where we have in house primary coaches, second graders are learning about brain development and growth mindset to set the tone for learning this year. Acting out a scenario, students participated as neurons making connections through repeated repetition and practice. Students experienced a visual of what is happening in their brains when they are learning something new that they may not understand. Students related their own experiences to the scenario. We will continue to focus on growth mindset and using mistakes and failures during our learning to reflect on and grow from. If there is not a primary coach in your building, look for resources sent from the GT Coach at your school.
